

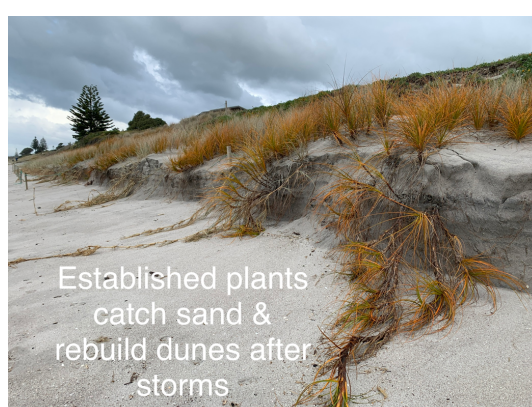


## Coast Care Update for Pukehina April 2021

### Dune planting season is coming up

Dunes are the backbone of our beaches and there's still lots of places on our stretch of coast that would benefit from spinifex & pingao. Adopt a spot, remove all the weeds and plant native sand-binding plants - spinifex & pingao!

They also provide bags for weeds to go in and collect them from the roadside at regular intervals.



### Update re actions following large storm event in 2020.



Planning and consultation with homeowners to complete **the second step in the push-up process from 2020, is underway**. In some areas the steep dune face behind the push-up will be reshaped. Planting will occur in autumn 2021 and Jim Dham will order these from Coast Care on behalf of the properties in the affected areas.
